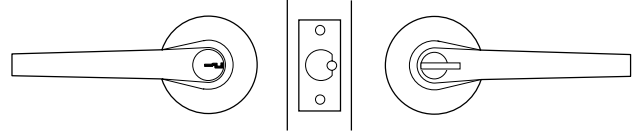
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929 and 949 Exterior Escape Deadlatch

Outside Opened by handle when unlocked. Key locks or unlocks exterior handle but does not retract the bolt

Inside Opened by handle at all times. Turnknob locks or unlocks exterior handle.



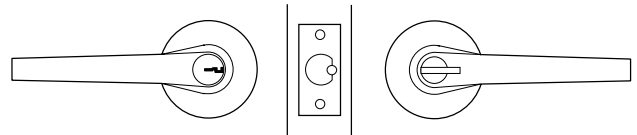

Inside Opened by handle when unlocked. Turnknob locks or unlocks both handles



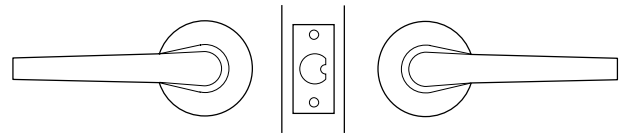

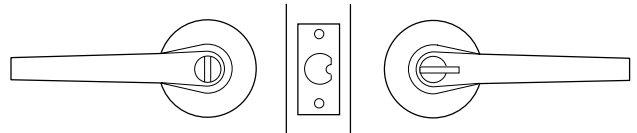

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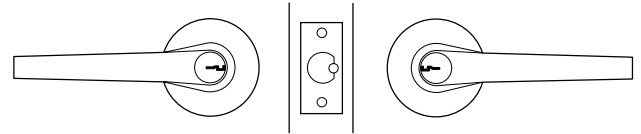
934 and 954 Glass Door Deadlatch

Outside Opened by handle when unlocked. Key locks or unlocks both handles but does not retract the bolt.

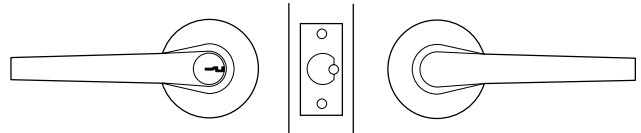
936 and 956 Exterior Escape Deadlatch

Outside Opened only by key. Key retracts bolt. Outside handle is rigid at all times.
